Believing in the motto “to affect life by life”, I have dedicated to participating and organising different local social services to serve the minorities since secondary 2. And my role has been transformed from a participant to a planner and leader in various voluntary groups and social projects.

In the CUHK Social Service Team, as the organising committee, I was responsible for designing innovative social services, contacting NGO for partnership and recruiting volunteers in CUHK. For instance, I designed a series of activities including making handicrafts with recycled materials, holding a daily science Q&A competition to serve the children suffered from cancers with the cooperation of Little Life Warriors Society. Another social service that I was in charge of is the partnership with Hong Kong Society for the Blind. There was a breakthrough that we organised a small scale outdoor orientation day for the blind people and the volunteers from CUHK; the activity was a success to improve the communication skills and team spirit of our service target.

Social Innovation with the Youth

In past three summers, I have had a new attempt to bring changes and innovation to our society by organising a youth program, in which workshops were given to inspire students to come up with a social campaign. In this year, under the theme of “Human Right”, we guided a group to launch a social engagement campaign to encourage citizens to step forward for the protection of the rights of the domestic workers in Hong Kong. I advised the group to execute their plan in Causeway Bay and gained over 200 acts to make a change together with us.

To Report the Unheard Voices

As a Journalism and Communication student, I volunteered in the Youth SPOT Magazine of The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups as a reporter and the team head of the Public Relations Team. By using what I acquired in lessons and school, I conducted interviews about the unheard voices in our society and wrote in articles to influence more people making a change. Also, we have initiated a social mental support campaign which encouraged Hongkongers to write something positive or tell a happy story on a postcard and exchange stories between strangers. More than 300 postcards were exchanged between strangers to spread happiness.

Spreading Humanitarianism

I have always dreamt to be a humanitarian worker for the less developed countries or war zone as my long term goal so I participated in the Red Cross Humanitarian Leadership Program. In the program, we are planning for the social project to put the concepts of humanity into practice in Hong Kong as the first step.

Last but not least, I would also like to take this chance to express my sincere gratitude to CUHK Convocation for this award. It is my honor to receive the award and it will definitely continue to encourage me to achieve my goal in helping more people regardless their ages, races, background and places.
