With this in mind, I hope to bring even more impact to society through technology and innovation, bring more impact to the Hong Kong ecosystem of innovations.

I grew up in a very normal family during my teenage years. While I didn't suffer from a seriously impoverished environment, we used to receive the full amount of students' assistance from Student Finance Office. There wasn't much spare money for joining tutorial classes or extracurricular activities. For many weeks, I had to eat cup noodles every lunchtime to save money.

However, I have the vision that I can always rise to be an influential and respectable person. Therefore, I pushed myself as hard as possible in DSE and worked with unremitting effort to achieve excellence in my studies and career.

I was inspired by influential innovators like Steve Jobs and Elon Musk, who are remembered as leaders who have helped human civilization advance into a new era. Because of them, I started learning a lot about computer science and programming. In my university years, I broke out of my comfort zone to take up leadership posts in college student-initiated events.

While many business students may occupy themselves in career-related internships, I took a different path – to take up responsibilities in my college and the university. I was an essential member of the student union of my college, where we held monthly conversations with college officials to voice out student opinions and established the first 24/7 printing station in the college. In the same year, I even took up leading posts in all three college anniversary events, hoping to make S.H. Ho College a vibrant place for students.

Later, I even served in the Representative Council of CUSU, the highest-ranked student organization on the campus where I processed numerous applications of university societies and discussed policies for the development of student societies.

My passion is education. I always want to pass down my experiences so I can be a role model for juniors. I organized trips for over 200 secondary school students and teachers to visit HKSTP and talk with start-up founders. I also designed a complete course on the integration of AI and business for more than 400 gifted students. I joined a volunteer teaching trip to Shaoguan in China to teach impoverished junior secondary school students about Economics.

In the past year, I have also been running a Youtube channel sharing my life in CUHK, now with more than 15,000 subscribers. Because of the positive image of CUHK portrayed in my videos, it was an honour to be invited by university officials as a guest for talks with freshmen.

With a dream of entrepreneurship, my ultimate goal is to revolutionize education. As a

current co-founder of an EdTech app, Flowclass - the online hub for personalized hybrid learning, we have funding support from Cyberport, CUHK, and HKU. I participated in PI Centre entrepreneurship talks as a host. We have also been featured on iMoney, SCMP, Metro Radio as a prominent startup founder from CUHK. None of these could be achieved without the support of my partners who have contributed unique expertise and brilliant effort to the project.

These experiences shaped me to be an ambitious person with a clear vision of contributing to CUHK and society. Even after graduation, I will develop myself in the field of start-ups. If chances allow, I will surely participate in university-related committees, where I will have a chance of voicing out students' opinions. It would be of a great honour to me if I could come back to guide the juniors, just like I did in my social media platforms.
